

# NEWLY PLANTED LAWN

For newly seeded lawns, set sprinklers (or hand water, whichever is applicable for your situation) to wet the surface 2-3 times a day based upon weather (see information below based upon temperature) to keep the seedbed moist, do not overwater so that there is pooling.

Begin watering early AM and ensure that watering is complete by early evening.

As newly seeded lawn grows to a height of 2-inches reduce the frequency to one time per day for a 20-minute cycle.

- Temps 79 degrees or Less: Water 2 Times Per Day:
- Temps 80 degrees or Higher: Water 3 Times Per Day:

Begin mowing after the grass has grown to a height of 3 inches. For your first mowing, remove just enough (1/2- to 3/4-inch) to give your lawn an even appearance. Mowing on a regular basis will encourage and promote new growth.

Fertilization and Weed Control applications are not to be applied within the first 30 days of lawn installation. Please do not be surprised if you see weeds growing in the new turf; this is very common. Expect 1-2 growing season for your yard to fully establish and mature.

This is the grass seed blend we utilized for your records: 50% Kentucky Bluegrass, 30% Perennial Ryegrass & 20% Creeping Red Fescue.

For hydroseed applications only: *We recommend an application of 22-16-6 Award Turf Fertilizer 1 month after the initial hydroseed application and a second application 2 months after the initial hydroseed application using a broadcast type spreader.*
